We've added a tour to a little known Willamette Valley gem, **The Bamboo Garden Nursery**, where nationally known bamboo expert and fanatic **Ned Jaquith** will talk about his experiences around the world with bamboo, and how you can use these exciting plants in your own garden. Tour the nursery with Ned to see over 300 varieties of hardy bamboos, one of the most diverse collections in the United States.

Closer to home, join award winning photographer **Allan Mandell** for a delightful and challenging intensive workshop exploring both the close-up (macro) and the wide scenic shots in **Big and Small: the Best of Both Worlds**. In this hands-on workshop, you will spend two mornings on location practicing your shooting skills, and spend the afternoons editing and critiquing your photos. Allan's sixth book as sole photographer, 'Garden To Vase,' made in collaboration with author Linda Beutler, was published last year by Timber Press. Paul Bonine, co-owner of Xera Plants and purveyor of really cool plants, brings us up to speed on the genus Lagerstroemia. Crape myrtles are beautiful flowering trees and large shrubs, featuring big, showy clusters of flowers in summer. Many types have interesting bark that exfoliates in thin flakes exposing lovely cinnamon or gray inner bark. Join professional garden photographer Allan Mandell for a 2-day intensive workshop concentrating on seemingly opposite ends of the visual spectrum. Explore the worlds of Big & Small through the macro close-up and the toughest shot of all, the overall scenic. Emphasis will be solidly on seeing & composition, with technical advice as needed. Shoot on location both mornings and edit/critique work in the afternoons.
